BRING YOUR HOUSEHOLD JUNK, BRUSH, TREE TRIMMINGS, DEBRIS, OLD APPLIANCES, AND OLD TIRES (4 PER HOUSEHOLD) TO THE COLLECTION POINT, TO BE LOCATED IN THE FIELD AT THE INTERSECTION OF S. WESTFALL AND CEMETERY STREETS (DOWN BY THE CITY CEMETERIES). YOU MUST SHOW PROOF OF BURNET RESIDENCY (DRIVER'S LICENSE &/OR UTILITY BILL STUB) PRIOR TO DROPPING OFF YOUR TRASH AND/OR JUNK.

THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED

WET PAINT BATTERIES APPLIANCES W/FREON ASBESTOS
HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS (SUCH AS: INSECTICIDES, HERBICIDES, ETC) CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS
