

VOTER ID LAWS CHANGE

Texas voters who cannot obtain one of the seven forms of approved photo identification now have additional options when voting in person provided by a court order that will be used in the November Elections. The seven forms of approved photo identification are: (1) Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) (2) Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS (3) Texas personal identification card issued by DPS (4) Texas license to carry a handgun issued by DPS (5) United States military identification card containing the person's photograph (6) United States citizenship certificate containing the person's photograph (7) United States passport.

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the approved photo ID must be current or have expired no more than four years before being presented for voter qualification at the polling place. The court order states that if a voter has a reasonable impediment to obtaining one of the seven forms of approved photo ID listed above, the voter may still cast a vote by: (1) Signing a declaration at the polls explaining why the voter is unable to obtain one of the seven forms of approved photo ID, and (2) Providing one of various forms of supporting documentation. Supporting documentation is described as: (1) Certified birth certificate (must be original) (2) Valid voter registration certificate (3) Copy or original utility bill, bank statement, government check or paycheck (4) Government document that shows the voter's name and address—if the government document has a photo, it must be the original document, not a copy.

NEW SOLID WASTE SERVICES

ACDI (Al Clawson Disposal, Inc.) is now the city's solid waste provider effective October 31, 2016.

Customers will notice that the new garbage carts are blue and the recycling carts are green.

Citizens have been notified of their new pickup days through the mail, however, if they are not sure, they should contact Utility Billing at the City of Burnet, (512) 756-6093. The garbage pickup days and the recycling pickup days are now the same. For example, if the trash day is Tuesday, the recycling day (every other week) will also be Tuesday.



AIRPORT REDEDICATION

The Burnet Municipal Airport will hold it's rededication and ribbon cutting ceremony at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 10th at the airport, 2302 S. Water Street, Burnet, TX 78611. The event will celebrate the completion of Phase One of the airport Master Plan. The event is open to the public.

The work for this phase included a runway overlay, a new taxiway, apron improvement, new LED runway and taxiway lighting and other technical improvements.
