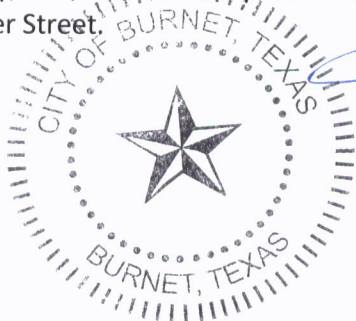
Discuss and review: Policy Rewrite/accreditation: Chief will send out section 4 titles for input from the board on what policies they want input in. No action taken.
