DISUSS AND REVIEW:

Welcome special guests and present Burnet Police Department Advisory Board topics for discussion: Police Chief Brian Lee presented an overview of the Burnet Police Department to include the Department roster and ranking of officers, the daily workload, the Safety Resource Officer responsibilities, the departments K-9 Program and general duties of the Police Department administration staff.
