A General Election was held on May 6, 2017 for the City of Burnet City Council. Mayor Gary Wideman had completed his term and is eligible to run for another term. Council Members Mary Jane Shanes completed her second term and is eligible to run for her third but decided not to. Tres Clinton and Paul Farmer have completed their first term on council and both were eligible to run for another term.

Qualified candidates for the May 6, 2017 General Election to fill the position of Mayor as follows:

Qualified candidates for the May 6, 2017 General Election to fill three Council Member positions as follows:

A total of 486 votes were cast in the election Philip Thurman received 218 votes and Crista Goble Bromley received 268 votes. Crista Goble Bromley will fill the Mayor's seat. Paul Farmer received 316 votes, Zachary Worrell received 84 votes, Cindia Talamantez received 209 votes, Tres Clinton received 325 votes and Ashley Barnett received 115 votes. Paul Farmer, Tres Clinton and Cindia Talamantez will fill the three council positions.
