<u>Project Update Report: C. Bromley:</u> Crista Bromley, Economic Development Director, reviewed the prepared project report with Council. The wastewater plant project is doing well and on schedule. The environmental review for the Sewer Line Rehab II project is ongoing by Texas Water Development Board. City Crews began replacing and repairing clean outs as identified in the SSES Point and Manhole Project Agreement. 588 manholes have been inspected by City crews.

<u>2012 Racial Profiling Report: P. Nelson:</u> Police Chief Paul Nelson reviewed the annual Racial Profiling Report with Council.

<u>REQUESTS FROM COUNCIL FOR FUTURE REPORTS:</u> Council Member Coker requested an update on the Delaware Springs Cart Path project from Doug Fipps. Doug reported that the project was progressing well and that he had received a lot of positive feedback from members. The project should be completed in the next 2-3 weeks.

Council Member Buddy Coker updated the Council on the progress of the Fire Station Project. The bid packages have gone out and deadline for submission is February 28<sup>th</sup>. To date there have been between 25 and 30 bid packets requested from contractors.
