Discuss and review: The Craddock House: D. Vaughn: City Manager David Vaughn introduced Ina Cooper, Chairman of the Friends of Cultural and Historical Preservation to start the discussion. Ms. Cooper introduced members from the City of Burnet Historical Board, Burnet County Historical Commission and the Heritage Society of Burnet that were present to discuss their respective groups concerns for the Craddock House. A brief history of the structure was presented. The groups present expressed the common desire to keep the structure where it is currently located and to refurbish the structure to be used as office space, a visitor center, museum or other venue that could generate revenue and increase tourism.
