<u>Proclamation: Youth Art Month:</u> Mayor Pro Tem Philip Thurman presented Samantha Melvin, Art Instructor at R.J. Richey Elementary, Fine Arts Studio, with a proclamation declaring the month of March as Youth Art Month in the City of Burnet. Ms. Melvin thanked the Council and invited all present to view the student's art on display at the Bob Bullock State Museum in Austin and soon to be at the YMCA in Burnet.
