(All of the following items on the Consent Agenda are considered to be self-explanatory by the Council and will be enacted with one motion. Approval of the August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Regular City Council meeting minutes: Council Member Milton Phair made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Council Member Joyce Laudenschlager seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

#### PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Public Hearing: First Public Hearing on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 1.012607 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted. Mayor Gary Wideman opened the public hearing and presented the item to the audience for comment. There being no comments, Mayor Wideman closed the public hearing.

Lewis: Council Member Paul Shell made a motion to approve and adopt the ordinance as presented. Council Member Philip Thurman seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Discuss and consider action: FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, PROVIDING FOR THE INVESTMENT OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE: D. Vaughn: Council Member Philip Thurman made a motion to approve the first reading of the ordinance as presented. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action:</u> Appoint members to the Burnet Board of adjustments: M. Lewis: Council Member Joyce Laudenschlager made a motion to re-appoint Russell McLesky, Joy Taylor, Steven Newton and Dale Myers to the Burnet Board of Adjustments for a term of two years ending in August 2016. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Award bid for Health Insurance Contract that provides employee health, dental vision, and life insurance: D. Vaughn:</u> Council Member Philip Thurman made a motion to award the bids for employee health, dental, vision and life insurance for fiscal year 2014/2015 to United Health Care. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Cancellation of Utility and Municipal Court Collection Service Agreement with American Municipal Services: P. Langford:</u> Council Member Milton Phair made a motion to approve the cancellation of the Utility and Municipal Court Collection Service Agreement with American Municipal Services. Council Member Mary Jane Shanes seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Discuss and consider action: Award of contract for Utility and Municipal Court Collection Services: P. Langford: Assistant Finance Director Patricia Langford informed Council that staff published notice seeking proposals for Collection Services on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2014. Four proposals were submitted to the City for consideration and the Evaluation Committee determined that the firm of Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott LLP (Perdue) received the highest overall evaluation score. The services provided by Perdue include debt collections for both Utilities and Municipal Court. Council Member Mary Jane Shanes made a motion to award the contract for Utility and Municipal Court Collection Services to Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, LLP. Council Member Milton Phair seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Discuss and consider action: Approval of the renewal of the Golf Now Marketing contract: D.

<u>Fipps:</u> Council Member Philip Thurman made a motion to approve the renewal of the Golf Now marketing contract. Council Member Milton Phair seconded, the motion carried unanimously. <u>Discuss and consider action: Appointment of a Finance Committee: Mayor Wideman:</u> Pass. No action taken.
