Public Hearing: The City Council of the City of Burnet, Texas will hold a public hearing on a request to abandon that portion of the alleyway located in Block 13, Johnson Addition to the City of Burnet, Burnet County, Texas and bounded by lots 3 and 4 to the north, and lots 5 and 6 to the south, said lots collectively being described as being 901 East Pecan Street: M. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Renewal of the Copsync Software Licensing Agreement for the use of Copsync Software at the Police Department: P. Nelson:</u> Council Member Mary Jane Shanes made a motion to approve the renewal of the Copsync Software contract for the Police Department and authorized the payment of the first four years in advance and receive the fifth year free of charge option. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Cost-Share Funding Program Agreement between the City of Burnet and LCRA. E. Milliorn:</u> Council Member Philip Thurman made a motion to approve the Cost-Share Funding Program agreement with LCRA and authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract. Council Member Paul Shell seconded, the motion carried unanimously.
