<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Wideman, at 6:30 p.m.

PUBLIC RECOGNITION/SPECIAL REPORTS:

<u>Proclamation: Patriot's Day: Mayor Gary Wideman:</u> Mayor Wideman read the proclamation declaring Friday, September 11th, 2015, Patriot's Day in the City of Burnet and encouraged all citizens to join in honoring our Armed Services, First Responders and the memory of those that lost their lives on September 11, 2001.

Approval of the August 25th 2015 Regular Council Meeting minutes

Council Member Paul Shell made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Council Member Joyce Laudenschlager seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Public Hearing: First Public Hearing on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 1.02353 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted: D.
