<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bromley, at 6:00 p.m.

<u>PLEDGE TO TEXAS FLAG:</u> Boy Scout Troop #282 Capitol Area Council presented and posted the colors and led the United State Pledge and the Texas Pledge.

CITIZEN COMMENT:

Home and property owners at the Ranch at Delaware Springs: Deborah Parker of 236 Sunday Drive, the Ranch at Delaware Creek, addressed the Council and presented a petition signed by residents of the Ranch at Delaware Creek requesting Council to consider changing the zoning of C-3 to C-2 for the property located on U.S. Highway 281 that backs up to their properties.

<u>Drainage ditch adjacent to Evergreen Street: Ruth Long:</u> Ms. Long, 304 Evergreen, Burnet, TX, addressed the Council and shared her concerns with the upkeep of the drainage ditch behind her property that abuts the Burnet Consolidated Independent School District property. The ditch retains moisture, is over grown causing a mosquito issue for the neighborhood. Ms. Long requested the drainage ditch be maintained and issues of flooding to several homes on the street be addressed.

Council Member Joyce Laudenschlager seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Approval of TxDot Aviation 2010 Capital Improvement Program remaining grant funding and designation of authorized representative: L. Baugh: Council Member</u>

Paul Farmer made a motion to approve remaining funding of the 2010 CIP grant with TxDOT Aviation and designation of City Manager David Vaughn as the designated representative. Council Member Cindia Talamantez seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Discuss and consider action: Approval of the 2018-2019 Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) grant with TxDOT Aviation and Designation of authorized representative: L. Baugh: Council Member Mary Jane Shanes made a motion to approve the 2018-2019 Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) grant with TxDOT Aviation and designation of Airport Manager Leslie Baugh as the appointed representative. Council Member Cindia Talamantez seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Ron Champion, President of the Hills of Shady Grove Property Owners Association (POA) approached the podium and addressed the Council on concerns the POA had with the passage of the resolution authorizing the acceptance of a deed for Public Right-of-Way from Stehling Developments, LLC. Mr. Champion shared the residents' concerns of the potential for change pertaining to the ingress and egress of the subdivision. The property owners would prefer the area to remain one way in and one way out. Concern for the potential decrease in property value was expressed to the Council as well. Council Member Paul Famer made a second motion to approve and adopt Resolution R2018-15 as presented. Council Member Mary Jane Shanes seconded, Mayor Bromley called for a roll vote. Council Members Laudenschlager, Shanes and Farmer voted in favor. Council Members Talamantez, Lester and Mayor Bromley voted against. The vote tied, the motion failed.
