

RESOLUTION NO. R2022-72

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES RELATED TO AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR AN AWARD OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND GRANT

Whereas, the Texas Department of Agriculture administers the Community Development Fund(CD); and

Whereas, the Community Development Fund is the largest fund category in the Texas Rural Community Development Block Grant ("TxCDBG") program; and

Whereas, recipients of funding awards may use the funds to benefit low and moderate-income neighborhoods through public facilities improvements such as water/wastewater infrastructure, street and drainage improvements and housing activities; and

Whereas, as applications for funding is competitive City Council deems it advisably to solicit the services of a professional consultant with TxCDBG program expertise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, THAT:

Section one. Findings. That the recitals to this Resolution are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section two. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to issue a solicitation for proposals from qualified consultants to administer the City's application to the Texas Department of Agriculture for an award of a Community Development Block Grant; and, to execute such ancillary documents and takes such related actions reasonably necessary to facilitate the intent of this Resolution.


