

RESOLUTION NO. R2026-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING JOINING THE “BURNET COUNTY HIGHLAND LAKES SUB-REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION” (BCHL SRPC); AND AUTHORIZING COORDINATION WITH OTHER COUNTIES, MUNICIPALITIES, AND OTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNITS

WHEREAS, Chapter 391 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes any combination of counties and municipalities to establish a sub-regional planning commission to address regional planning needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Burnet finds that the City and surrounding governmental entities share common planning concerns affecting transportation, infrastructure, land use, economic development, and other matters impacting the region; and

WHEREAS, cooperative planning among affected governmental entities is in the best interest of the citizens of Burnet and will promote orderly growth, efficient use of public funds, and protection of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that participation in the Burnet County Highland Lakes Sub-Regional Planning Commission (BCHL SRPC) will enhance coordination and regional collaboration consistent with Chapter 391, Texas Local Government Code

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Findings. The recitals set out above are hereby approved and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section Two. Approval. The City of Burnet hereby approves the creation and joining the Burnet County Highland Lakes Sub-Regional Planning Commission (BCHL SRPC), to be formed pursuant to Chapter 391, Texas Local Government Code. The purpose of the BCHL SRPC shall be to coordinate regional planning efforts, including but not limited to:

- a) Planning for transportation systems and related infrastructure improvements;
- b) Promoting the orderly provision of streets, utilities, public facilities, health, educational, recreational, and other essential services;
- c) Supporting agriculture, business, and industry within the region;
- d) Promoting safe, healthful residential environments;
- e) Preserving historical and cultural resources;
- f) Encouraging efficient and economical use of public funds; and
- g) Cooperating with federal and state agencies on matters affecting the region.

The City's corporate boundaries shall be included within the geographic area represented by the BCHL SRPC.

Section Three. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized and directed to take those actions that are reasonably necessary to facilitate the purpose of this Resolution.

Section Four. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.

Section Five. Effective Date. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and approval as prescribed by law.
